



## TENSE REVISION

**It's 13:00 in Istanbul**

**A) Guess what people are doing around the world now.**

Target Language: Present continuous tense

EXAMPLE: It's 13:00 in Istanbul now and I think most people are having lunch. It is Saturday so I'm guess some people are working but some people are doing something fun with their friends.

05:00 in New York

8:00 in Rio de Janeiro

10:00 in London

17:00 in Bangkok

19:00 in Tokyo

21:00 in Sydney

**B) Let's talk about what people usually do at this time on Saturdays.**

Target Language: Present simple tense

EXAMPLE: At 13:00 on Saturdays, people usually have lunch in Istanbul. Some people work on Saturdays so at 13:00 they have lunch in their offices or they sometimes go out to a café or a fast food restaurant and have a quick lunch with their friends. Some people don't work and they get up late on Saturdays so they usually do some housework or go shopping. Students usually do their homework.

05:00 in New York

8:00 in Rio de Janeiro

10:00 in London

17:00 in Bangkok

19:00 in Tokyo

21:00 in Sydney

**C) It was Friday yesterday. Guess what people did at around this time yesterday.**

**Target Language: Past simple tense**

**EXAMPLE:** People were at work or at school yesterday so at 13:00 they probably had lunch. Some people ate their lunches at their work or schools and some people went out to eat something.

05:00 in New York

8:00 in Rio de Janeiro

10:00 in London

17:00 in Bangkok

19:00 in Tokyo

21:00 in Sydney

**D) It is Sunday tomorrow. What will people do? Make guesses.**

**Target Language: Future simple tense**

**Example:** It is Sunday tomorrow. Majority of people won't work and they will wake up late so probably they'll have breakfast or they'll watch a movie or they'll go to a park at around 13:00 tomorrow.

05:00 in New York

8:00 in Rio de Janeiro

10:00 in London

17:00 in Bangkok

19:00 in Tokyo

21:00 in Sydney
